The Triduum of Easter is the holiest time of our Catholic calendar. Over the Triduum (The Three Days), we celebrate one Liturgy. We begin on Holy Thursday evening with the Mass of the Lord's Supper. On Good Friday the Liturgy

continues with the Passion of the Lord. The Vigil on Holy Saturday evening marks the beginning of the new Easter, and the Mass on Easter Sunday morning begins the new Easter Day. Put these days in your calendar and make every effort to celebrate the Triduum.

Sacrament of Reconciliation. There will be a celebration of the sacrament of Reconciliation on 21 March, 7.00pm.

As well as the usual time before Sunday Mass, 7.45-8.15am, and there will also be time available for the Sacrament of Reconciliation over the Holy Days of Easter.

The Mass of the Holy Oils (Chrism Mass) will be at St Francis Xavier Cathedral on Tuesday 26 March, 7.00pm. It is a diocesan celebration and you are very welcome to attend.

The next Children's Liturgy of the Word will be **this Sunday ** 10 March during the 8.30am Mass.



Profession of Faith (Credo) The Nicene Creed


I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God. begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us all and for our salvation he came down from heaven, Bow your head for the following words: and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man. Then continue: For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified,

who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.
